

FAIR Animal Photographer Job Description

Time required: Approximately 3 hours per week

Animal Photographers:

1. Report to the Animal Photograph Manager
2. Respond to weekly scheduling e-mail to volunteer for a day at one of the FAIR adoption sites
3. Arrive at the adoption site an hour or two after opening
4. Take digital pictures of dogs, cats, and other adoptable animals at the site
5. With the help of an Adoption Site Assistant, remove the animal from its cage or kennel, maintain control over the animal, and put the animal back in its cage or kennel after the photo session
6. Send the photo files to photos@faircares.org.

Animal Photographers should have:

- Completed FAIR Orientation
- Read and understood the FAIR Photographer Instruction Manual (<http://www.faircares.org/fairphotos/PhotoInstructionManual.pdf>)
- Access to a digital camera and a personal computer with an Internet connection
- Ability to work both independently and as part of a team
- Knowledge of:
 - Proper companion animal care and handling
 - Animal and human health and safety
 - The physical and behavioral characteristics of companion animals
